Excess Cost



During the 23-24 SY Canton received Excess Cost reimbursement in the amount of \$859,252. The percentage of reimbursement was at a rate of 70.5% of the excess costs vs. the 88% that was originally promised by the State of CT.

Excess cost refers to the additional expenses incurred by a school district beyond the standard costs associated with providing education to students without disabilities. This could include: Out of district tuitions, therapies, evaluations and related services.
