7th GRADE ORIENTATION

We invite all of our incoming 7th grade students to join us for an orientation **Monday, August 25, 2025 from 10:00 to 11:30 a.m.** This event is for students only and we greatly appreciate your efforts in arranging transportation. Orientation will take place on site at CMS. Students should be dropped off in front of the school; staff will be outside to greet them. During the orientation, students will receive their class schedule, receive their school Chromebook, meet their teachers, tour the building, engage in team building activities and learn some information that will help them succeed on the first day of school. Students will be dismissed to the front of the school at 11:30 a.m.

PowerSchool access to schedules will become available on Monday, August 25th.

- Any 7th grader who cannot attend orientation (and all 8th graders) can access their schedule on PowerSchool at that time.

We will also have printouts of schedules available on the first day of school.

FALL SPORTS INFORMATION

CMS offers cross country and field hockey in the fall. Registration must be complete via Final Forms, and a physical must be on file with the nurse, before a student can participate.

Pay to Participate: CMS athletics are "Pay To Participate" for this school year. For all athletic programs at CMS in the 2025-26 school year, students will pay \$100 per student per sport. There will be a family cap (no more than \$375 per family including all their students in grades 7 - 12) and scholarship opportunities for families with need. Further details will be provided as sports seasons approach (including how the payment can be made via Final Forms).
