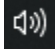


# Windows 10 Speaker and Microphone Troubleshooting

---

- Right click on  in the lower right corner of the screen
- Select **Open Sound Settings**
  - Use the **Output** (Speaker) drop down to change devices and test each one until you find one that works. If possible click on [device properties](#) and name is something clearer for future reference. You should have a video with sound playing to test.
    - Adjust the audio level as needed with the slider
  - Use the **Input** (Microphone) drop down to change devices and test each one until you find one that works. If possible click on [device properties](#) and name is something clearer for future reference.
    - Under Device Properties for the mic you are able to adjust the volume level, check to make sure it isn't set too low.
    - Testing the mic you will see the bar fill with blue if the mic is active

Test your microphone



*\*If you are using headphones, Windows may try to use a mic associated with the headphones by default even if it doesn't exist, so you may need to switch to the built-in mic on your device using this method*
