- From CollegeBoard at the NACAC (National Association for College Admission Counseling) Convention (Louisville, KY):  
“While the number of test optional schools continues to grow, we are focused on continuing to provide important data to students and increasing college access for all.”
  - University of Chicago becomes the most highly competitive college (5.9% admit rate/2019) to move to test optional
  - Students who use Khan Academy report score increases
