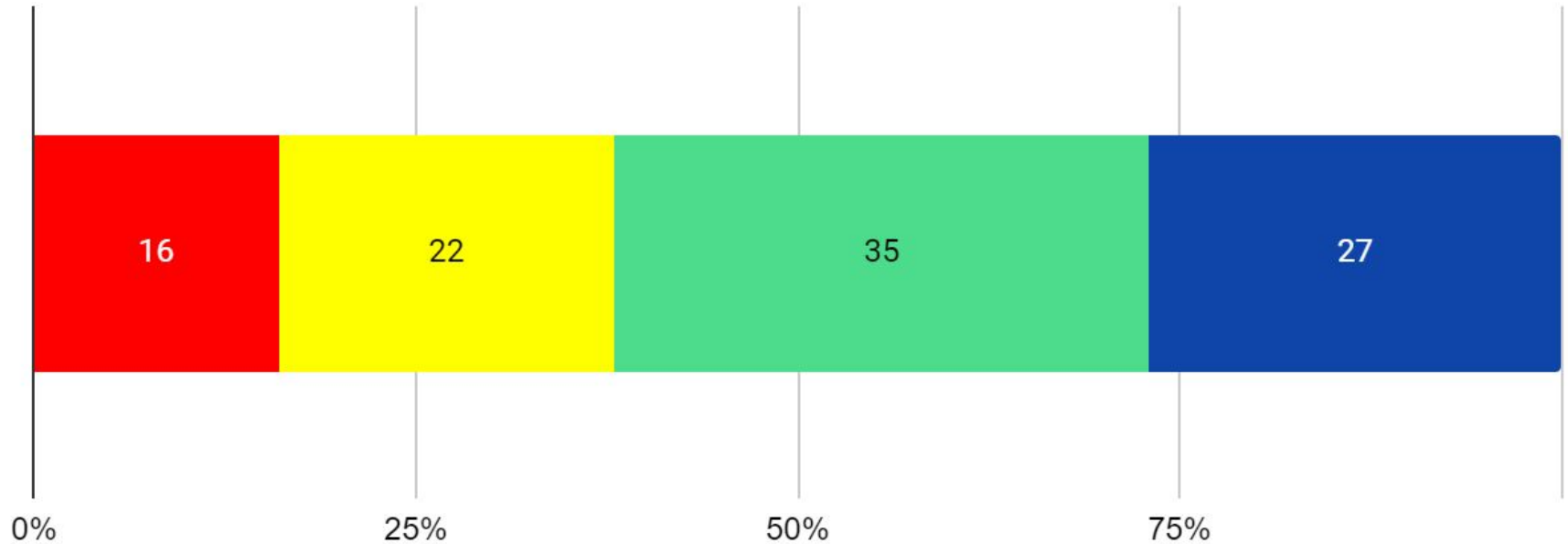

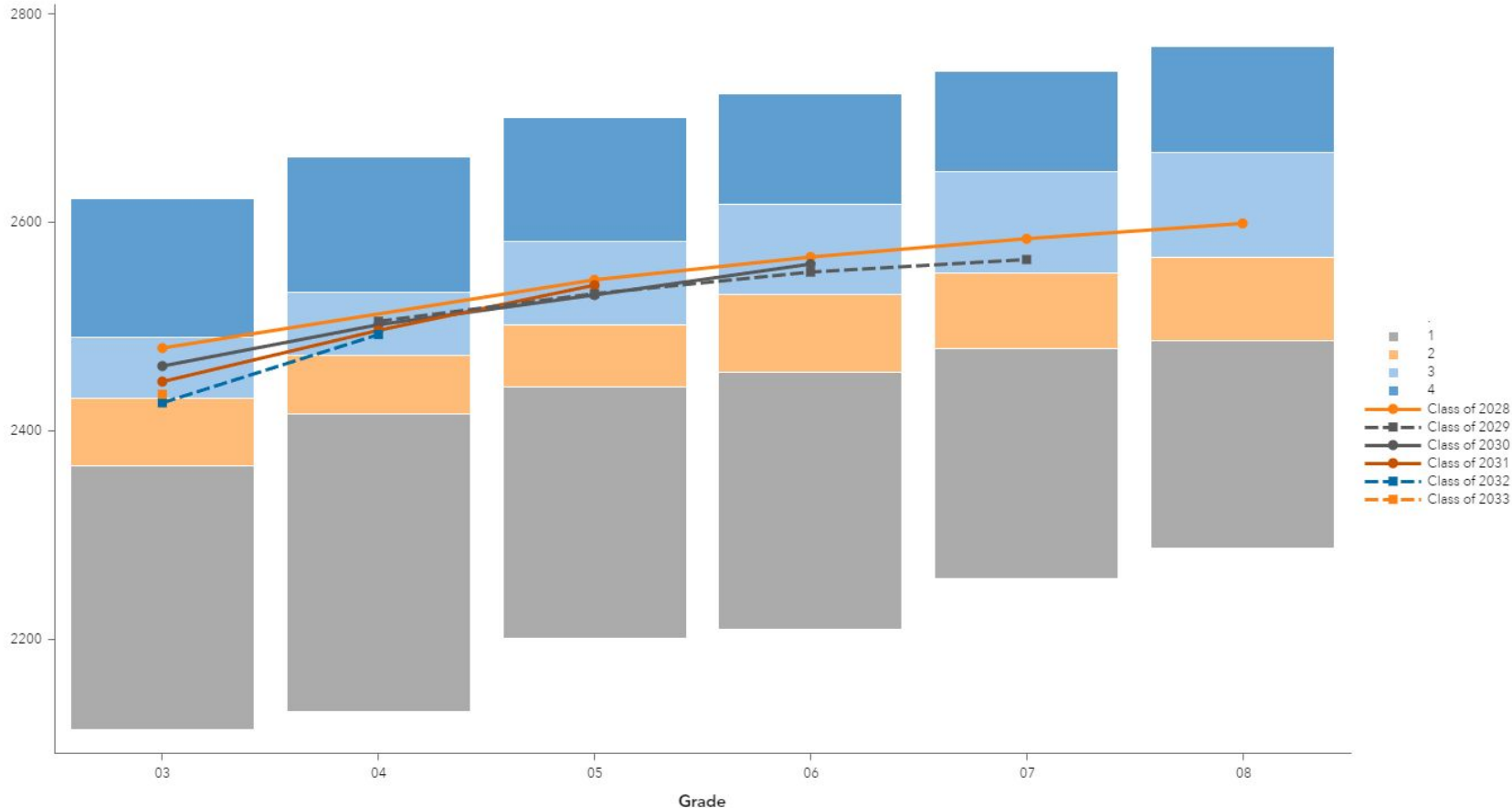

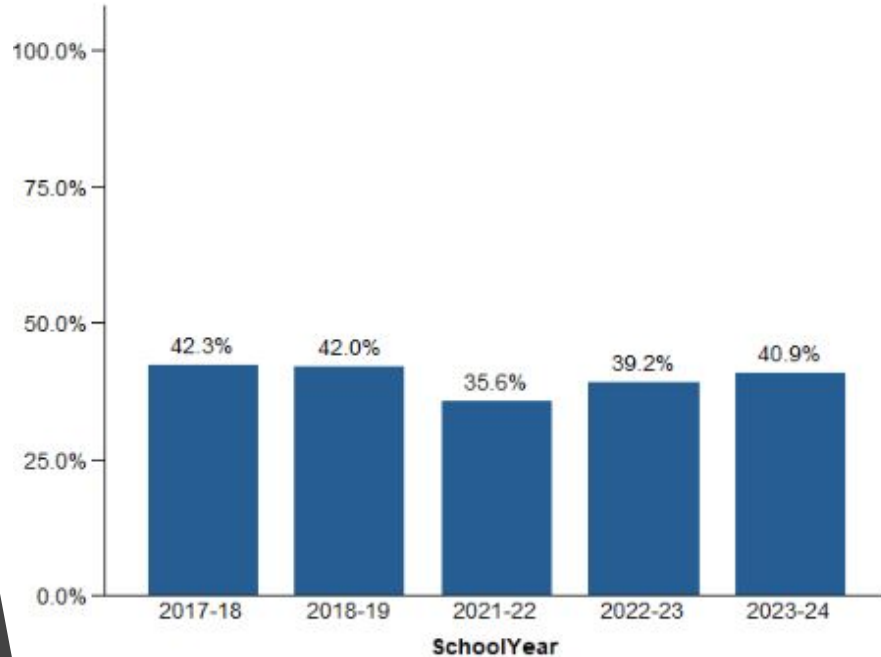

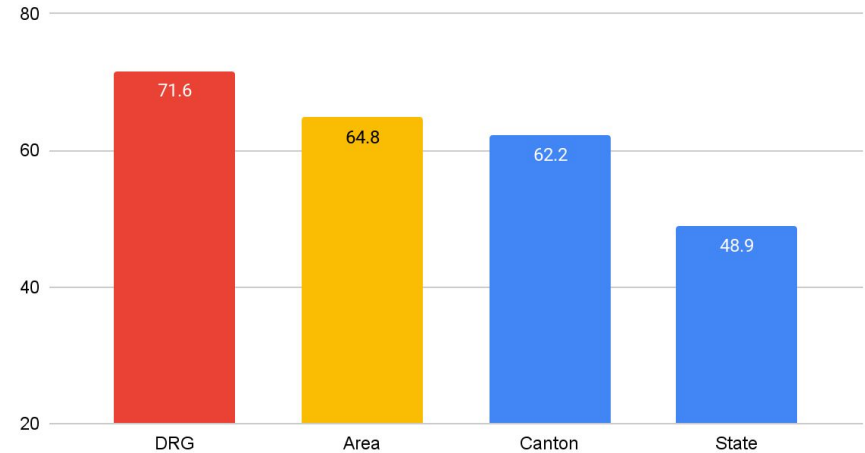

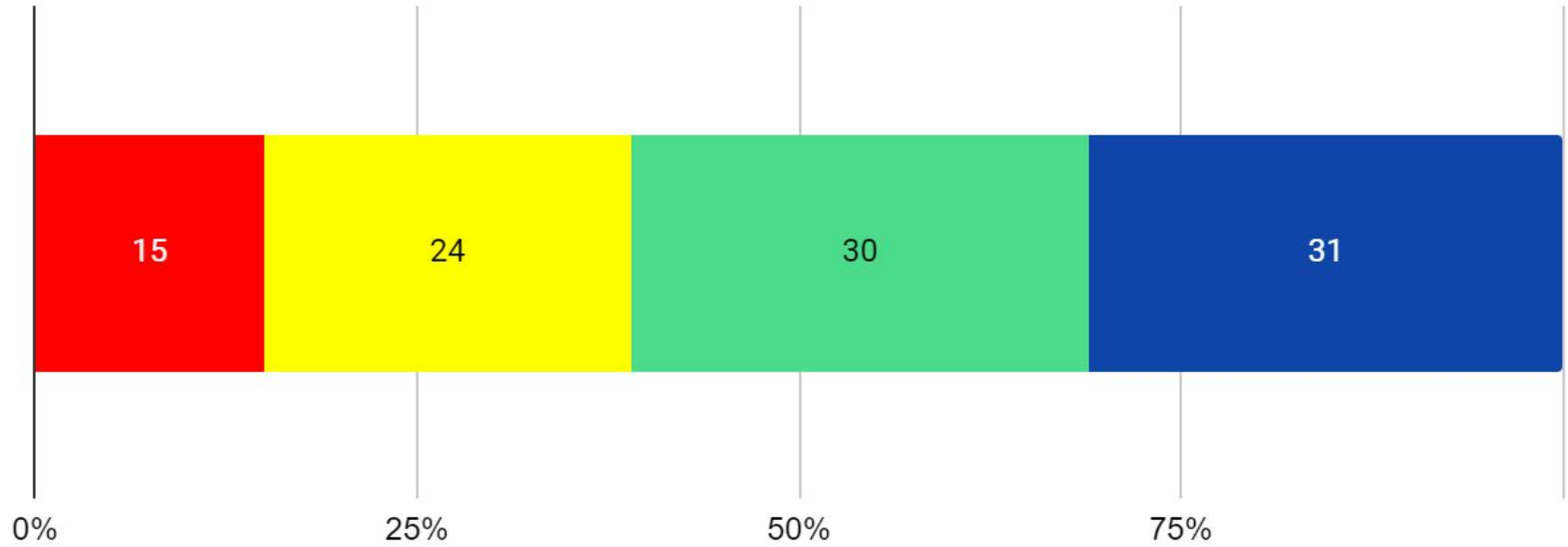

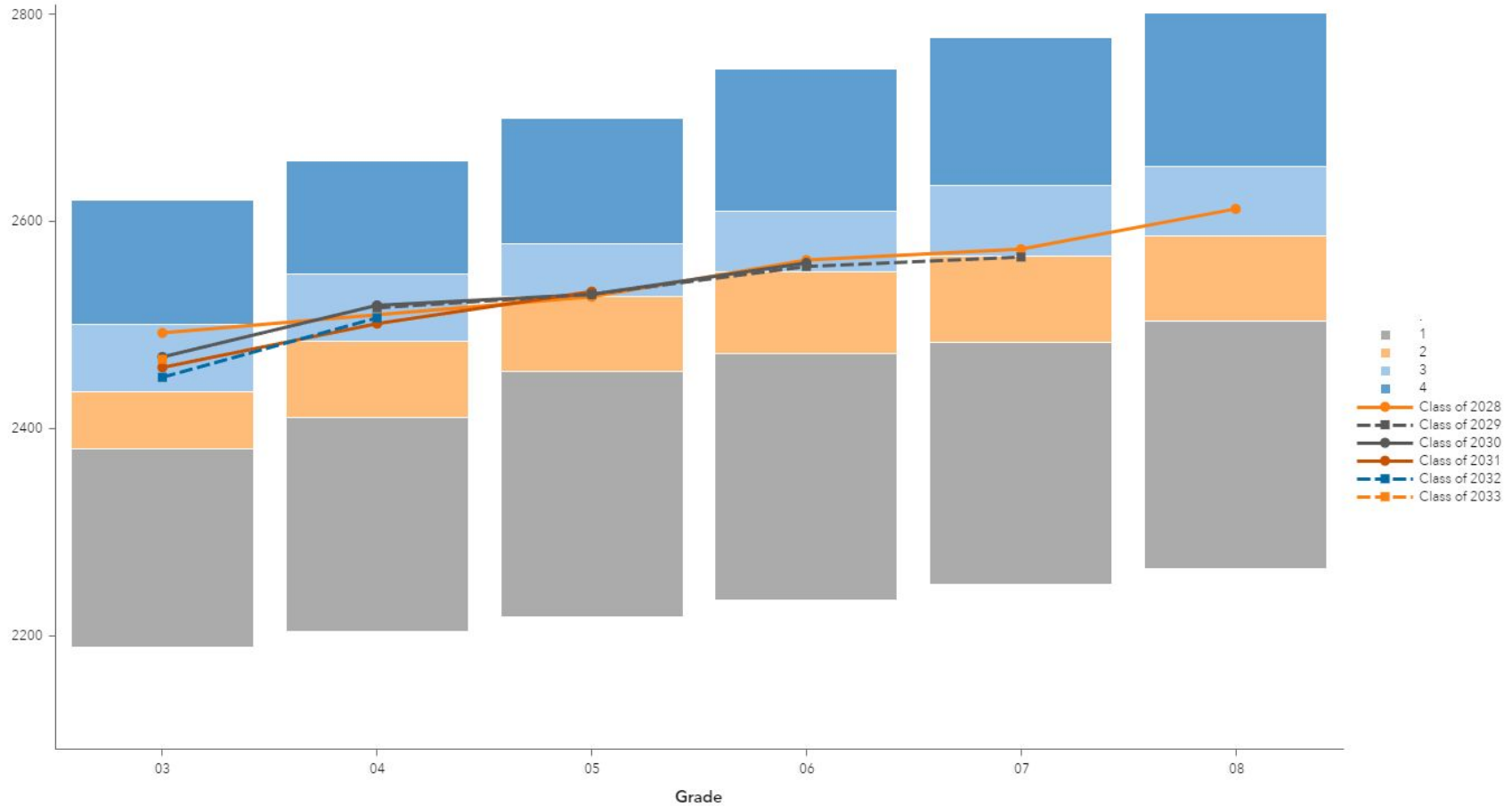

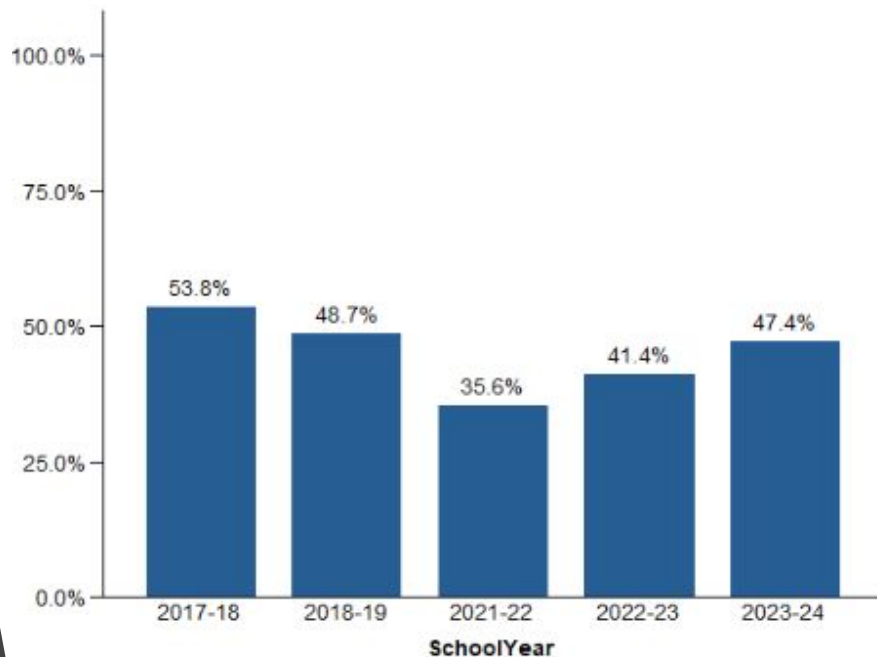

## Math Average Percentage of Target Achieved

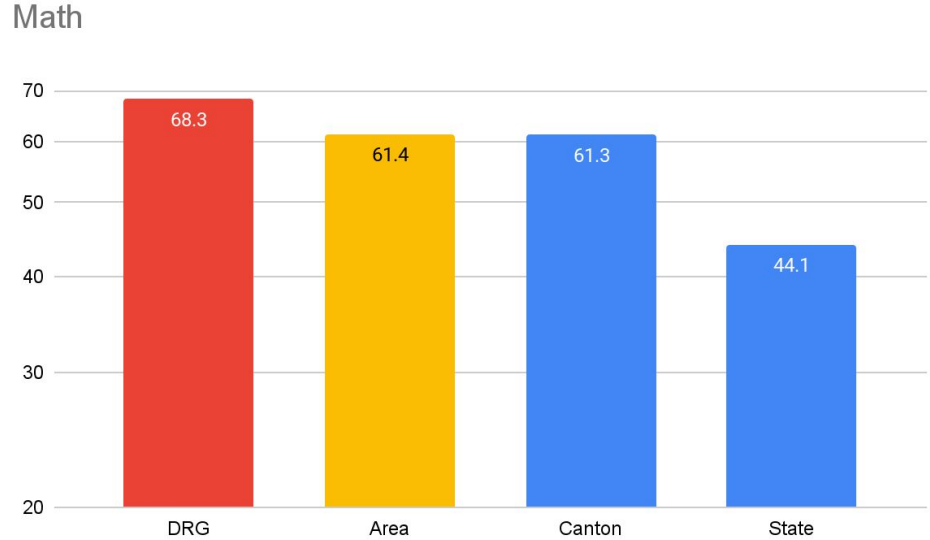

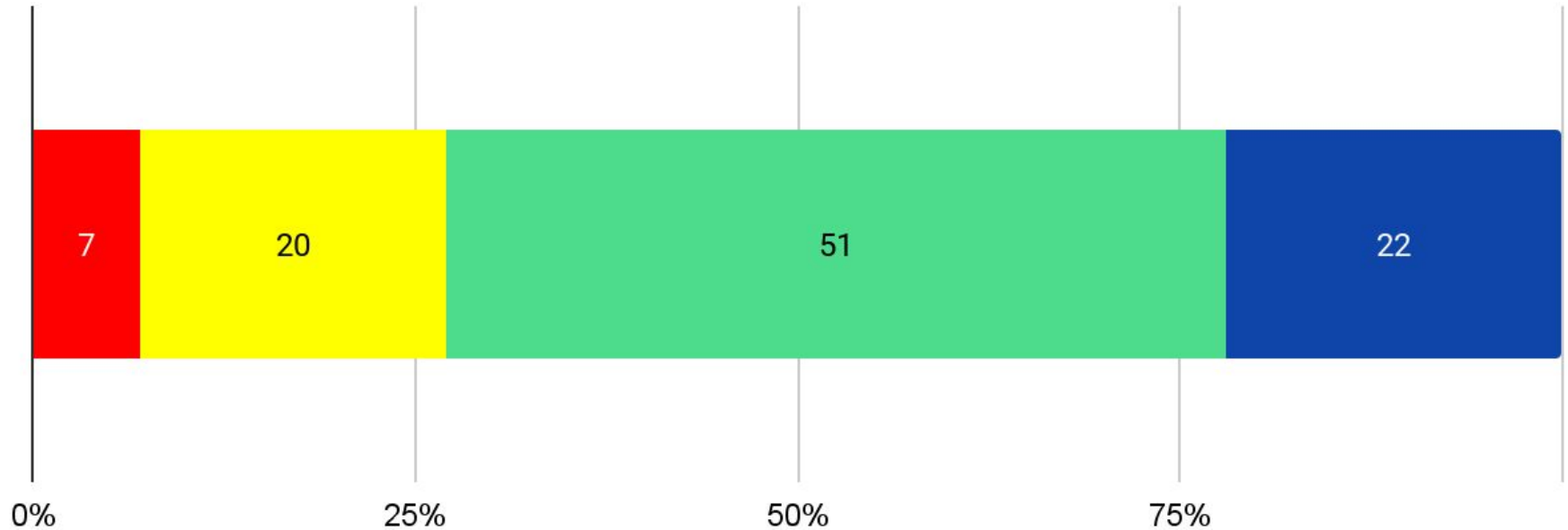

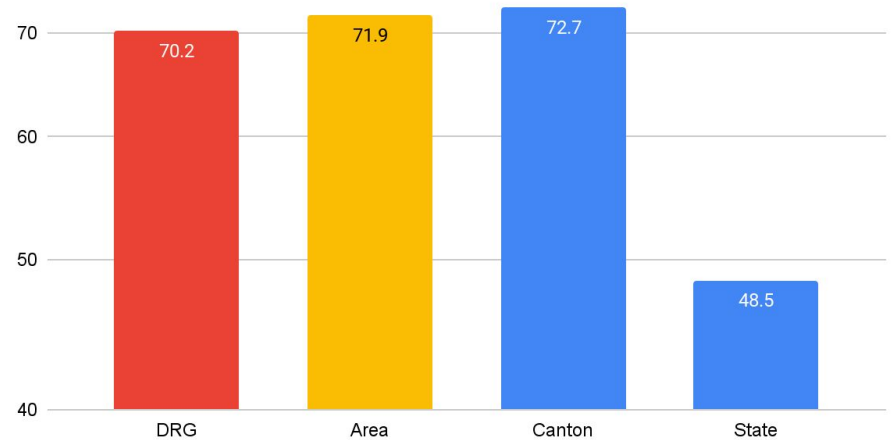
